Brielle's Story

A Fighting Chance

At age 11, Brielle complained to her mom that she was having a hard time seeing at school. A visit to an optical shop in the mall meant new glasses. Except the glasses weren't helping so she stopped wearing them. Then her mother noticed Brielle counting stairs aloud (a behavior common in blind people to remember how many stairs they'll have to climb) but she just spend \$400 on glasses, then she remembered that her new job offers her Opticare Vision and she made an appointment for Brielle the next day. The Opticare provider saw something alarming and referred her to a neuro-ophthalmologist where she was diagnosed with a brain tumor called craniopharangyioma - a non-cancerous pituitary tumor that was pressing on her optic nerve. Brielle had successful brain surgery a few days later to remove the tumor. Brielle lost vision in her left eye completely, but an eye exam saved her life. "I'm afraid to think what would have happened if I didn't have Opticare," says Staci, Brielle's mom. "I would have waited to take her to another eye doctor had it not been for my vision benefits at work, which according to our neurosurgeon would have been fatal." Brielle's condition can be fatal even though it is not painful, which is why sight threatening conditions can be called silent diseases.


INTERNATIONAL WORK
